Dean Johanesen - M.I. Music Classes



BACKGROUND - Hello, My name is Dean Johanesen. I am a Long Island, NY native who now resides in Sarasota, FL. My wife Penny and I have been married since October of 1996 and we have a son born Feb of 1998 named Said who is currently serving in the US Army.

I am the oldest of 4 with 2 children adopted into our family by my mother and I grew up in a home that fostered a number of children over the years. Little did I know this would be somewhat of a training period in my life for teaching and working with kids.

I started playing the guitar at the age of 14, took lessons a couple of years after being self taught, performed in Jazz Band and Pop Group through high school as well as playing with friends in bands and went on to a music college in Dix Hills NY called Five Towns College of Music.

Both my family experience and my music experience were propelling me toward a career that I had no idea about until a few years after my son was born.

When my son reached Pre-school age, I began volunteering to go in and sing songs at his school. Singing songs lead to bringing in instruments from home for the children to play and from there I was offered a weekly spot that inspired me to establish my own music program for pre-school aged children.







MUSIC PROGRAM - I call this program M.I. Music Classes, the M.I. stands for Music is Instrumental. I also felt the ownership (M.I. or My) was an important part for the title to give ownership of the class to each child. The program focuses on giving children a "hands on" experience with instruments at an early age and teaching some of the basic building blocks of music such as tempo, dynamics, rhythm etc.

I am currently teaching this program throughout Bradenton and Sarasota at privately owned and operated preschools. I started teaching and developing this program 13 years ago, thanks to my son, and I continue to love my work in hopefully educating and inspiring the children I work with as much as they educate and inspire me.

CLASS SCHEDULE - Class times are typically 15 - 30 minutes long depending on the age range of the room. Every class starts with a sing along that incorporates a mix of songs to encourage music and movement as well as learning the basic principles taught in preschool - rhyming, counting, colors etc.

After the sing along potion of class, we learn about the instrument of the week. We talk about the parts and every child gets to take a turn playing or holding the instrument.
